





A BRIEF HISTORY

Asquith Golf Club was officially opened on 18th June 1938 by the Hornsby Shire Council President, Councillor C.H. Sommerville, and was originally a nine hole course.

The land, which was leased by a group of local entrepreneurs, had been used previously as an orchard and also contained a dog racing track that was located on the current 2nd fairway.

A function was held on the opening night at the old Clubhouse, which, at that stage, was a cottage located on Royston Parade.

The original Clubhouse was a "log cabin" that was built towards the end of 1938. It was extended five times over the years to meet the needs of the increasing membership.

When the current Clubhouse was completed in Lord Street in 1970, the old Clubhouse was used as a kindergarten for some time, until it was sold to the Jehovah's Witnesses in 1988.

In the late 1950s, it was decided to expand the course to 18 holes, a decision taken in the knowledge that the Club would be responsible for relocating that part of the course affected by the proposed building of the Sydney to Newcastle Freeway at some stage.



There was an element of risk involved, but had the decision to expand the course not been taken when it was, it is extremely doubtful that the Club would enjoy the excellent 18 hole test that exists today.

The original 18 hole layout, which by now included two dams to make the Club self-sufficient in water, and a fairway watering system, was played from 1965 to 1986.

When the Wahroonga to Berowra section of the Sydney to Newcastle Freeway finally commenced in 1986, it necessitated the complete reconstruction of seven of the last nine holes.

Costs were kept to a minimum by the use of voluntary Club members' labour, reciprocal assistance from the Freeway contractors, reuse of existing greens and materials and by obtaining over 100,000 cubic metres of fill without cost to the Club.

It is this spirit and "can do" attitude of members over the years that have turned Asquith into the great Club you find today. Notwithstanding this, during the years 1985 to 1990, the Club spent well in excess of \$800,000 on the work and associated capital costs. Not cheap, but well worth it judging by the lasting legacy of a magnificent course that has been enjoyed by many thousands of golfers over the years.

Looking back, the first 75 plus years has seen Asquith Golf Club develop from its early beginnings as the dream of three gentlemen who had a lot of vision and enthusiasm to bring golf to one of the outlying suburbs of Sydney.

It is now a friendly, professionally managed Club with a challenging, well-manicured course, a strong competitive spirit and well-developed traditions.

Asquith Golf Club is now an ethnically diverse Club that is not just a major sporting asset for Hornsby and District but is also well integrated into the local community for its role as a meeting place and as somewhere to enjoy a wide range of celebrations.

THE COURSE

Any club is only as good as its course and Asquith Golf Club is fortunate that it has a real gem that will delight everyone from the experienced golf professional to the casual player.

The par 70 layout for men stretches to 5,494 metres off the men's blue tees, with a scratch score of 70 and a slope rating of 134. It features three par 3s and two par 5s on both the outward and inward nines. Women enjoy a 5,055 metre par 71 challenge, playing one of the toughest par 4s on the course, the 18th, as a par 5. The slope rating off the women's red tees is 137.

While the course is not overly long by today's standards and there are some par 5s reachable in two, that doesn't make it easy. Payback comes the nearer the green you get because it's not just the repetitive test you find on so many courses of hit the middle of the green, two-putt and move on.

Rather than being mundane, Asquith Golf Club offers something out of the ordinary but in a good way. More proficient players are also able to show their skill at working the ball both ways in order to negotiate the numerous doglegs and put themselves in the optimum position to hit the green.

Driving accuracy is at a premium, miss the green and the golfer will find a variety of tests being posed and choices offered

The bunkers are not numerous, but positioned in such a way that they do good business. A number of water hazards to negotiate don't just prey on the mind, they can potentially damage your scorecard.

The course has always been highly regarded and it invariably looks a picture. The immaculate presentation a tribute to the painstaking work of our dedicated Course Team. It is playable all year round.

We are immensely proud of our course, and we are not alone. First-time visitors often remark on the well-manicured fairways and evenly paced and true rolling nature of the greens, which are a delight to putt on.

Has it stood the test of time? You bet! Modern technology has yet to find a way to tame the traditional course where ability to control ball flight in the wind and a vivid imagination to vary trajectory and club selection depending on the prevailing conditions, triumph over being able to hit it prodigious distances.

Everyone will have their favourites, but the 13th is the longest, most challenging and scenic hole on the course. It is also one of the best par-5s in the whole of New South Wales. Don't take our word for it, though, both the Sun Herald newspaper and Pacific Golfer magazine have at various times picked it among their favourite 18 holes in Sydney.

Even on days when the bounces are not being kind or the putts refuse to drop, there is the beauty of the natural surroundings to savour and the Clubhouse welcome to look forward to.

Most of all, there is the desire to come back and do it all again, because tomorrow's challenge will be something entirely new again.

TOUR THE COURSE

We hope you enjoy your time with us at Asquith Golf Club. Here are a few useful tips and course notes that should help you make the most of your round if you have never visited us before.

Distances shown are from the men's tees.

Hole 1 (Ironmonger's Knob) 424 metres, par 5

A short par 5 to start with and a real birdie chance, but the bunker down the left and two down the right side of the fairway require an accurate drive of 220-250m to slot through the small gap between them. The green slopes from front to back, requiring a high shot in to hold the green. The green has two deep bunkers at the front and deep hollows around the green.

Hole 2 (Dog Track) 270 metres, par 4

A short par 4 and a good birdie chance for lower markers. The big hitters head over the trees on the right, but a mis-hit or sliced tee shot will catch those trees and end up in trouble. Missing the green will mean a difficult up and down. Downhill putts on this green are usually quick.





Hole 3 (Legend's Lookout) 188 metres, par 3

Long par 3 with very large green protected by two front bunkers. It is a long carry and simply reaching the putting surface does not guarantee a par. Two-putting here can be quite challenging, particularly over the ridge which divides the green.

Hole 4 (The Buzzard) 379 metres, par 4

Tough par 4, rated number 3 for men. A difficult tee shot which is over water, with more water left of the landing area and a row of trees to the right. The second shot is blind or semi-blind to a narrow green guarded by a nasty bunker left, which should be avoided. The green is flat, but tricky surrounds make getting up and down difficult.

Hole 5 (Railroad) 339 metres, par 4

Mid-length par 4, out of bounds left to worry the hookers, but a fairway which cambers right means any tee shot hit with a slice will usually find its way into the row of trees down the right side. The second shot is played to a long green guarded closely by a dam on the right side to catch the slice and a lone bunker on the left.



Hole 6 (Little Devil) 144 metres, par 3

Medium-length par 3, with a green surrounded by bunkers. The green slopes sharply from left to right, so any downhill putt can be very quick indeed. Par is always a good score here.

Hole 7 (Roon the Ben) 376 metres, par 4

A very difficult par 4, rated number 2 for men, a nightmare for slicers. A row of trees left of the tee makes it tough to get the tee shot in the right position. Any left-to-right breeze or a headwind brings the dam on the right into play and makes the hole play much longer than its yardage. A severely sloped green and deep bunkering on the left and right sides create more problems.

Hole 8 (Heartbreak Hill) 434 metres, par 5

Longish, uphill dogleg par 5, not too demanding provided the player stays on the fairway. Long hitters will go for this green in two but the second shot is usually blind and over the dogleg. Golfers must avoid missing the green to the left, which leaves a next-to-impossible chip to an away-sloping green.

Hole 9 (Lord's Prayer) 159 metres, par 3

Medium length par 3 which is quite innocuous from the forward tees but becomes more of a test the further back the tees are located, bringing into play the out of bounds left and a fall away to the right. A sloping green is protected by a bunker to the left and a deep rough-filled hollow front. Always try and leave yourself an uphill putt on this green.

Hole 10 (Stage Fright) 364 metres, par 4

An extremely tight tee shot on this medium length par 4. Hitting the fairway here is extremely important with heavy trees to the right and a water hazard to the left on the adjacent 11th hole. An uphill second shot to a smallish green which sits at an angle is hard to hold. The approach shot which is not quite up will roll back, leaving a tricky chip.

Hole 11, (Goosey Glen) 313 metres, par 4

A short but demanding par 4, this hole requires pinpoint accuracy from the tee to a small landing area. Low markers will often attack this hole with driver, a gamble which can bring trouble into play. A shortish, uphill second shot to a large, treacherously contoured green where three putts are commonplace. For its modest distance, this hole is quite a test.

Hole 12 (Entertainer) 134 metres, par 3

A short uphill par 3 which does not pose too many problems. Rated 15 for members, most players will be looking for a par here. A fairly flat green is protected by a bunker on the front left.

Hole 13 (Braw View) 478 metres, par 5

Long par 5 which is trouble from start to finish. The first shot from an elevated tee is hit to a wide, undulating fairway cut short by a large dam which usually forces a lay-up for longer hitters. Not always though, as some gamble off the tee with driver in an attempt to access the peninsula on the right which brings the green within reach in two shots. The second shot over the water requires accuracy and distance. The shot into the green is fraught with danger; any shot missing left or long is destined for trouble. A two-tiered green adds to the difficulty. Many a good round has been ruined here.



Hole 14 (Spring Gully) 126 metres, par 3

A short, tight, tricky downhill par 3 which tests the player's nerve. It is always hard to choose a club here, especially if it's windy. The severely sloped green is surrounded left and back by out of bounds. The green is extremely tough, particularly the left side. All golfers are happy to walk off this one with a par.

Hole 15 (Amen) 463 metres, par 5

Another hole which has brought many a player undone, the 15th is the third leg of our "Amen Corner". Any golfer with a slice fears the tee shot here, with out of bounds right to around 170m from the tee. The dam on the left is a factor for longer hitters' tee shots. The second shot here must find the fairway, leaving a clear shot to a well-protected, long, narrow green with two tiers.

Hole 16 (Spook's Corner) 347 metres, par 4

Dogleg left par 4 which plays much longer than its yardage for the average golfer. Most players are unable to reach the corner of the dogleg from the tee, necessitating a gambling second shot over the trees to a green where out of bounds skirts close by on the right. A hole where distance from the tee is a real advantage, most players would be advised to lay up the second shot safely at the bottom of the hill.

Hole 17 (The Rock) 163 metres, par 3

A great par 3, with a green that sits at an angle to you. The green has 3 sections to it, a front left, back left and right side all at different levels. The trick with the tee shot is be on the same level as the pin for an easier putt. The ball can be fed onto the green from the right, for those trying to avoid the large bunker to the left of the green and to a lesser extent, the pot bunker in the front of the green.

Hole 18 (Home James) 393 metres, par 4

Index 1 for men, this tough par 4 completes a demanding finish to the Asquith layout. A strong drive is essential here if the player is to get anywhere near the green in two hits. The tee shot must avoid out of bounds right with thick trees and a hazard left. The long second is fraught with danger as well, with trouble all the way to the green on the right and a deep bunker and trees on the left. A stern test indeed, this hole is played as a par 5 for the ladies.


